Pleasanton Unified School District is pleased to welcome a new addition to your walk-through registration process. Pleasanton Partnerships In Education Foundation (PPIE) will be present at every school site's registration event with information about the new district-wide educational foundation efforts. PPIE has funded programs that have been reduced or eliminated (due to the state budget crisis) including counselors and reading specialists (school year 09/10) and technology and library specialists and student support programs (school year 10/11 and 11/12). Over the past few years, PPIE has raised over \$1,500,000 for these programs on behalf of PUSD and our students.

PPIE's fundraising goal is to have every PUSD family, as well as the entire community, get involved with helping to fund programs that directly affect your children. The short term goal for school year 12/13 includes literacy and student support programs (such as Class Size Reduction; reading intervention; programs for at-risk and high-achieving students; and additional sections at high schools); science and technology programs (including specialists); and health and well-being programs (such as counseling services and physical education instruction)
